



COVID 19 Public Health Order

The Saskatchewan Ministry of Health's Chief Medical Health Officer has issued a number of orders to reduce the risk to Saskatchewan people and prevent transmission of COVID 19.

A number of provisions in the March 20, 2020 order will have effects on public health inspected facilities. Below we have provided some clarity on certain affected facilities in response to commonly asked questions.

The goal of these measures is to reduce or eliminate contact between people in your facility. All facilities should continue to practice enhanced cleaning and disinfection measures.

Bars, lounges, night clubs and similar facilities are restricted to take out (with 2 meter distancing between customers in line-ups) and delivery only.

Restaurants, food courts, cafeterias, and similar type facilities have been restricted to only having take out food service, drive through food service, and food delivery.

- Social distancing should be practiced in all facilities, including 2 meter distancing between customers in line-ups for take-out foods.
- Seating areas should be closed all facilities, including but not limited to:
 - Restaurants, cafes, coffee shops;
 - Delis/ready-to-eat food service within grocery stores;
 - For retail and convenience stores serving ready to eat food;
 - Cafeterias; and
 - Hotels and similar public accommodations with food or breakfast.

Recreational and entertainment facilities have been ordered closed. This includes hotel pools and hot tubs.

All personal services facilities have been ordered closed. This includes hair salons, tanning studios, tattoo shops, etc.
